BUMPER / JUNIOR LEAGUE RULES

INTRODUCTION

• Participation in the Rhinelander Area Bowling Club and Bumper/Junior Leagues is a privilege; therefore every participant must be willing to abide by the rules set forth by the club and Nick's Hodag Lanes.

RULES

- No carry-ins of any kind (drinks or food) are permitted.
- At league, appropriate clothing should be worn for bowling. If you can't wear it at school, don't wear it at league.
- All students are prohibited from:
 - 1. Buying, selling, possessing or being under the influence of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs.
 - 2. Using or possessing tobacco in any form, including cigarettes, vaping, chew and/or snuff.
 - 3. Theft or misuse of bowling center property.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, including: gestures, verbal or physical bullying, pushing or shoving a coach or another student, deliberate fouling, loud or vulgar language or abuse of equipment and facilities is prohibited. Coaches or center officials will have the authority to remove anyone (bowler or adult) for any of the above reasons.
- During league play, bowlers will be expected to follow the previous bowler promptly and will be required to bowl as soon as the lanes next to them are clear.
- Coaches, league officials and bowlers are the only persons authorized to be in the settee area during the match or practice. Parents or any other interested parties must remain behind the area defined as the settee area.
- Absolutely no youth, without a parent/guardian present, are allowed in the main bar area.

IMPORTANT BOWLING INFO

- Pre-bowling is allowed if you know you are going to miss a day of bowling. This MUST be set up with Nick or Jennie at the bowling alley and also let Mike or Cory know of your intentions to Pre-Bowl.
