The Florence Lacrosse doubles event is open to all female bowlers of the Northwoods USBC who have paid their membership dues The tournament scores will be taken from league games bowled the week of January 30, 2022. The following rules apply:

- 1. USBC rules apply
- 2. Doubles will consist of any two female bowlers from the **SAME** league.
- 3. Bowlers may bowl this event in as many leagues as they are members of, but must have a different partner for each league.
- 4. Last year's highest average from any sanctioned Northwoods association league will apply (see the Northwoods average book). This is a USBC rule and cannot be modified. Handicap shall be 90% of 230. New bowlers will use current average (minimum 21 games).
- 5. Substitutes may bowl, but must be sanctioned in the league, be present on the sub list for that league, and have a minimum of 21 games in that league by January 23, 2022. This same requirement applies to rostered substitutes.
- 6. Entry fee is \$12/bowler (\$24/doubles team). This must accompany the entry form and be given to the league manager prior to starting the event. The league treasurer will send a CHECK for all entries to the tournament director.
- 7. All entry fee monies paid back in trophies or cash. Payouts 1 place per 5 teams.
- 8. Special consideration will be made for extenuating circumstances on a case-by-case basis.
